Spay Neuter Certificate Program: certificates for low-cost surgeries at local participating vets purchased via the organization's web site. Certificates, which cover surgery and some related services only, are \$85 for a female cat and \$61 for a male cat and \$74 for a male dog and \$110 for a female dog. Upon receipt of on-line order and payment, Friends of Animals will process the order and mail certificate within seven business days. Cat Spay/Neuter Clinic: Services for cats are available for \$45 for neuters and \$65 for spays. Services for dogs, \$50 for neuter up to 50 lbs. in weight, \$85 for neuter 51-75 lbs in weight, and \$100 for neuter 76-100 lbs. in weight; \$95 for spay up to 50 lbs. in weight, \$115 for 51- 75 lbs. in weight, \$150 for 76-100 lbs. in weight, and an additional \$25 per 25 lbs. in weight over 100 lbs. Proof of vaccinations (rabies and distemper combination) must be provided or pets will receive vaccines for an additional \$10 each. Prices vary depending on veterinarian and extra services may be required. Fix Lancaster Spay Neuter Program: Services for cats, males for \$75 and females for \$95. Services for dogs, \$115 for neuter up to 40 lbs. in weight, \$130 for neuter 41-80 lbs. in weight, \$145 for neuter 81-100 lbs. in weight, and \$185 for neuter over 100 lbs. in weight; \$135 for spay up to 35 lbs. in weight, \$160 for spay 36 to 75 lbs. in weight, \$185 for spay 76 to 100 lbs. in weight, and \$225 for spay over 100 lbs. in weight. Rabbit neuters provided for \$75. Vaccinations and other services also provided at the time of surgery. To schedule call 717-983-8878 or go to web site to schedule on line.

**SNAP (The Spay Neuter Assistance Program)**

Spay Neuter Express: Surgeries arranged directly through local veterinary practices for dogs and cats. A \$25 deposit is required, which will be applied to the final bill. Set price for the surgery (with no additional fees), plus mandatory pain medication and low-cost vaccinations if pet is not up-to-date on vaccines.
