The cost per cat is \$40, and includes spay/neuter, rabies and distemper vaccines, pain medication, and ear tipping (no exceptions). Feral Cat Voucher Program: Contracted municipalities provide vouchers for free surgery. Check first with your local government to see if these vouchers are available. If your municipality is not contracted with the HSHA, you can use the general surgery clinic option. If you have received a voucher for a free surgery from a contracted municipality, call the HSHA at 717-564-3320, Option 2. You will need to present the voucher and a legal photo ID at the time of the surgery. (The Nobody's Cats Foundation accepts vouchers at its clinic; see details below. PAWS also accepts vouchers at its clinics; see details below.) Humane traps available for loan.

Cat Spay/Neuter Clinic: Surgeries for cats (a minimum of 4-5 months of age and no older than 7 years of age) are available for \$40 for neuters and \$60 for spays. Proof of vaccinations (rabies and distemper combination) must be provided or cats will receive vaccines for an additional \$10. TNR Clinics: Low-cost clinics at the society shelter in Myerstown, with spots reserved on a first-come, first-served basis. No more than three spots reserved for a single individual per clinic. Cats must be brought in a trap or carrier. Cost for the clinics is \$30 per cat, which includes the spay and neuter surgery and a rabies vaccine. All cats will be ear-tipped for identification purposes. NO EXCEPTIONS. Additional services offered include a FVRCP vaccine for \$10, a FeLV/FIV test for \$20, and flea preventative and deworming treatment for \$10.

Spay Neuter EXPRESS Program: Surgeries provided by Silver Springs Animal Clinic in Mechanicsburg (Mondays) (766-5980); by Palmyra Animal Clinic in Palmyra (838-5140); and by Colonial Park Animal Clinic in Harrisburg (Fridays) (540-7140). Rates: males \$25 and females \$40 for SURGERY ONLY. Additional mandatory charges of \$26 for rabies and distemper vaccinations and pain medication, and \$5 for ear tip. Cats must be 16 weeks old and in good health. A refundable deposit is required. To schedule your surgery, please call the practice directly. Additional Alternatives: Numerous local veterinarians participate in SNAP's low-cost program by honoring the following rates for SURGERY ONLY: Males - \$25; Females - \$40. Contact the specific veterinary office to ensure that practice will provide surgery for free-roaming cats. Also note that additional charges may occur due to mandatory clinic services/costs. Ensure that you receive an estimate of all charges PRIOR to scheduling your surgery.
